Glad hymns of praise from land and sea.

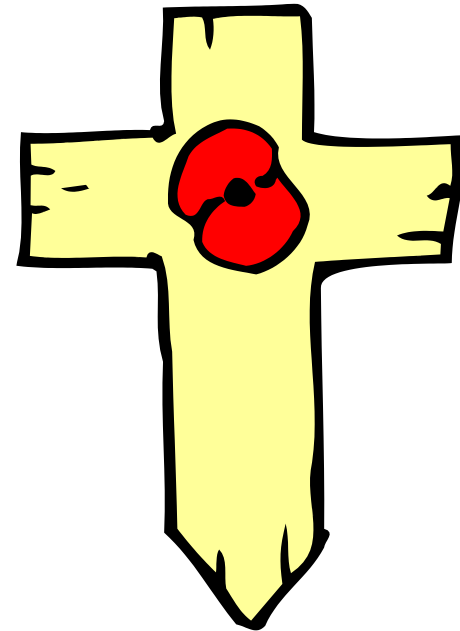
